LOCAL WATER LAW NO. 1 ADOPTED IN 1995

Discontinuance of service for non-payment. All bills are due and payable, net cash, within 30 days after rendition. In case any water bill or charges provided for in and by these rules shall not have been paid within 60 days following the rendering of the bill, the Village may discontinue water service to the customer, and service will not be reinstated until the water charges are fully paid.

Any persons wishing to have their water service temporarily suspended or reinstated on their property will need to go to the Village Office and submit their request in writing with the Village Clerk. This request will need to be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 and the quarterly billing will continue as usual. This fee of \$25.00 will be required for both shut off and resuming of water services. This fee will be required for every resident within the Village Water System – no exceptions!

Sewer Use Law - Revision 2001

Section 1108 - Water Supply Severance

Whenever a User has violated or continues to violate the provisions of this Law or an order or permit issued hereunder, water service to the User may be severed and service will only recommence, at the User's expense, after it has satisfactorily demonstrated its ability to comply.

The User may, within fifteen (15) calendar days of severance, petition the Village Board to reconnect water supply service. Such petition shall be in written form and shall be transmitted to the Village Board by registered mail. The Village Board shall then:

- (1) Reject any frivolous petitions,
- (2) Reconnect the water supply, or
- (3) Order the petitioner to show cause in accordance with Section 1109 and may as part of the show cause notice request the User to supply additional information.
