## SNOW ORDINANCE



Beginning December 1<sup>st</sup>, the village of Stamford's snow ordinance will go into effect. Any vehicle left parked on village streets, when a winter storm is forecasted, after 1AM until 7AM, will be ticketed and fined \$50.00, which will be issued with a \$100 fine for each subsequent ticket. If a second ticket is issued the vehicle will be towed and stored at the owner's expense on village property. If after one month any vehicle remains unclaimed, it will be sold at a Village auction. This ordinance will remain in effect until April 30th. It is the owner's responsibility to be aware of the weather!

### **Local Law Number 1 of 2015 Amending a Local Law Regulating Parking in the Village to Establish Additional "No Parking" Areas**

Be it enacted by the Village of Stamford as follows:

§ 1 – Amendment to Establish Additional "No Parking Areas".

Section 2 of Local Law No. 3 of 1991 (as amended by subsequent local laws) is hereby amended to add a new subsection to prohibit parking as follows:

Located at 77 Main Street – the first six (6) spaces commencing twenty (20) feet from curb line of Main St., also known as State Route 23 then continuing fifth-five (55) feet on the east side of said parking lot. These spaces shall be designated as one (1) hour parking spaces from the hours of 10AM and 6 PM daily. All violators will be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.
