Present: Joan Hinman , Mayor; John Bonhotal, Deputy Mayor/Trustee; Reid Golden and Darren Hanway, Board of Trustees; Joe Hornbeck, Public Works Superintendent; and Gena Swantak, Village Clerk. Absent: Maryann Dwyer, Trustee.

Mayor Joan Hinman called the special meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Public Forum: Vincent Scalice provided information on the Outreach, for Veteran's, that opened at the Delaware Inn.

The State Police Lease was reviewed.

John Bonhotal made a motion for Joan Hinman to sign the lease, Seconded by Darren Hanway. Motion passed. John Bonhotal – yes, Darren Hanway – yes, and Reid Golden – yes.

Two park use forms were submitted for review.

John Bonhotal made a motion to approve both applications, Seconded by Darren Hanway. Motion passed. John Bonhotal – yes, Darren Hanway – yes, and Reid Golden – yes.

Bride NY Local Project agreement (DOT) was submitted.

Joe Hornbeck presented quotes for brush attachments.

Joe Hornbeck proposed the idea of leasing a vehicle for 2-3 years. Joe will look into several alternative options and present them to the BOT.

Joe Hornbeck will look into estimates for the dog park construction.

Joe Hornbeck asked what to do in the case of multiple meters at a location, and if one apartment is vacant – should the landlord be responsible to continue paying for the water, even though it is shut off.

The BOT will require all residents to follow the law concerning the water. Suggestion was made to send a copy of the law to any resident in question of the commitment, to the resident, in these cases.

Joe Hornbeck mentioned that an engineering inspection Report was needed. Joe Hornbeck will get information and John Bonhotal and Joe Hornbeck will work together to put an RFP together.

John Bonhotal will touch base with the former technology teacher in Stamford, who was going to have his students build a shed for the Ice Rink.

There was a complaint about the parking on South Delaware street. The suggestion of a one way street was made by the resident making the complaint. The board discussed this option and came to the conclusion that South Delaware Street is a major cross Street for Hobart and cannot be made into a one way street.

Utility Easement for Heather Clark's property was submitted.

Reid Golden made a motion to have Joan sign the easement, Seconded by John Bonhotal. Motion passed. John Bonhotal – yes, Darren Hanway – yes, and Reid Golden – yes.

Reid Golden made a motion for a donation up to \$50 for Maryann Dwyer, Seconded by John Bonhotal. Motion passed. John Bonhotal – yes, Darren Hanway – yes, and Reid Golden – yes.
