- Emergency Meeting of Stamford Village Board 3/17/20
- In attendance Robert Schneider, Jim Kopp, John Mark Bray, Darren Hanway
- Called to order at 0900
- Emergency meeting was called to discuss NYS Governor executive orders related to COVID-19 Response, i.e. Staff reduction, social distancing and suspension of the open meetings law, and any open Village items
- In light of NYS executive order to reduce municipal employees in office by 50% Stamford Village Hall office hours will be changed as follows:
 - 1 - Window hours on Monday, Wednesday and Friday 0900-1600
 - 2 - Office to remain open with Gena in office
 - 3 – Sandy to work from home once Gena can establish VPN in consultation w/ Villages IT partner, ISD
- Additionally regularly scheduled meeting of the Board for this evening is cancelled
- Budget meeting to review and approve next FY water and sewer budgets was scheduled for 1100, Friday, 3/20/20
- Public response to the pending location of Tractor Supply Company to a property just outside the Village limits was discussed. While the property lies within the jurisdiction of the Town of Harpersfield, it is recognized that this will impact adjoining Village of Stamford properties, and in light of some of the public feedback on this topic it was decided to
 - 1 – Have Gena request a copy of existing Town of Harpersfield zoning for Stamford Village Board to review
 - 2 – If this zoning allows for input of neighboring uses to be considered, then at a time allowable after COVID-19 restrictions have been rescinded, Village will hold a Town Hall meeting facilitated by Darren & Jim to get public input to take to the Town of Harpersfield Planning Board.
